### Q: Why are we going?

- A:

### Q: What will you be doing?

A: The camp has a great weekend planned with all kinds of fun activities as well as meaningful Chapel times with a guest speaker & band. The list is long but here's a taste: toboggan run, sledding, broom ball/hockey, ice skating, snow ball fights, and large group games outside; dodge ball, basketball, & volleyball tournaments in the gym; evening coffee house & breakout sessions.

### Q: How much does it cost?

A: The trip costs \$195 per person (*includes: all meals, lodging, activities, programs, & transportation*). It is by far one of our best trips & well worth the investment! Each teenager must have participated in the fund-raising to get a discount. Scholarships are also available, but you must participate in fund-raising to be eligible.
