Q: Why are we going?

Q: What will you be doing?

Q: How much does it cost?

A: The trip costs \$375 per person (*includes: all meals, lodging, activities, service projects, programs, & transportation*). It is going to be a great trip & well worth the investment! We have been doing a fund-raising in order to help cut the costs of the trip. Each teenager must have participated in the fund-raising to get a discount. Scholarships have been made available as well, giving the students a significant discount. Many of you are already paid up, but in case you have not, the final trip cost is \$200 (\$175 off). Spending money for snacks/gifts is optional.
