Small Group

Kids will learn how to apply the principles learned in Jam Sessions to their daily lives.

The total cost of camp is \$300. All registrations require a \$50 **non-refundable** deposit. Included in the cost are 3 nights lodging, 9 meals, t-shirt, activity and camp fees, and transportation.
